



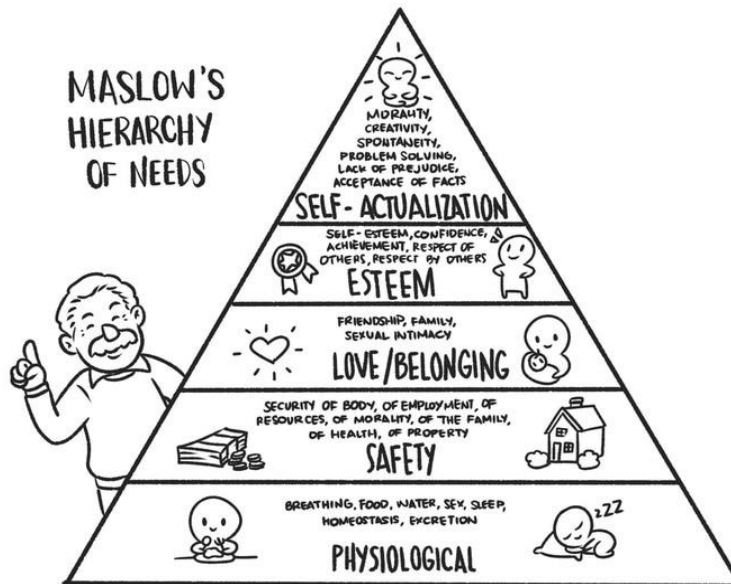

6.6 GRADE 1 – 2022

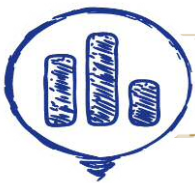
Grade 1 - 2022 online applications open at 08:00 on 13 September 2021, and close on 8 October 2021.

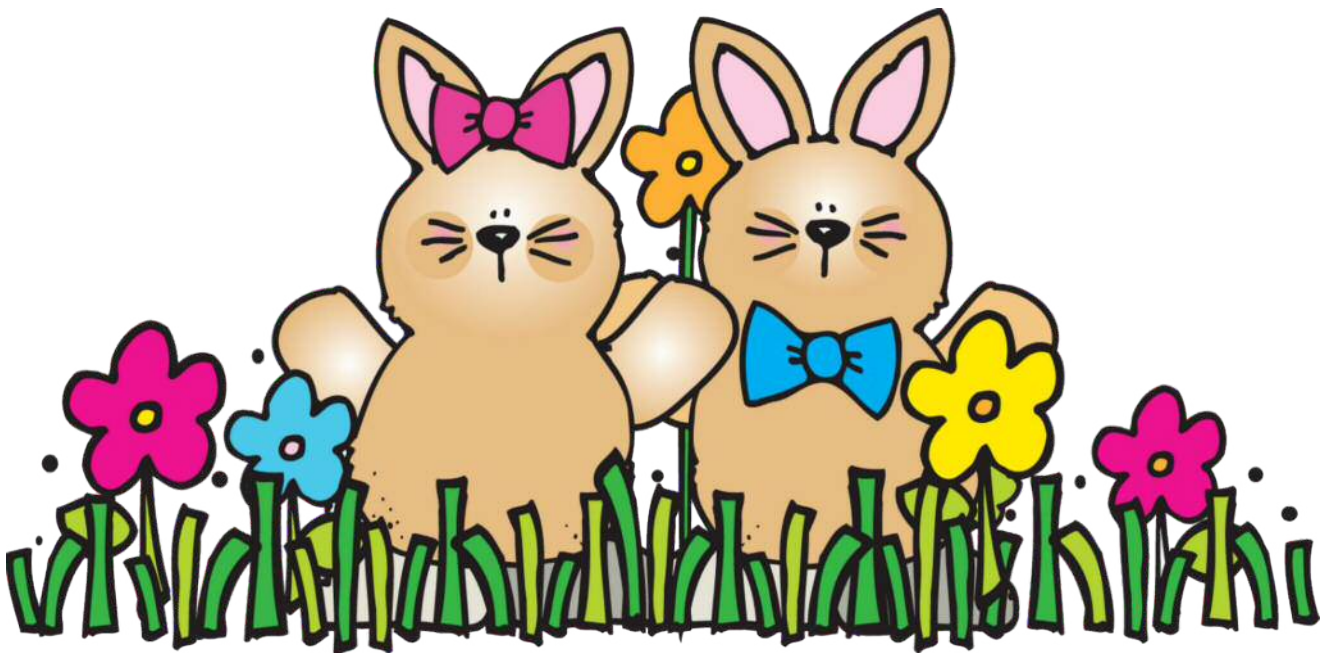
