5. Educational

5.1 ASSESSMENT – 2ND TERM

- Already received.
- Help and support your child with reinforcement.

5.2 SHOELACES

- Teach your child to tie his/her own shoelaces.
- Now is the ideal opportunity since the learners' wear shoes.



5.3 PUZZLE

- Build puzzles with your child.
- Technique:
 - Build the corners and sides first, and thereafter the centre part.
 - Let us look at the picture of the puzzle! (Visual discrimination).

5.4 SKIPPING ROPE

- Learner can hop and skip comfortably, without a rope, at first.
- Then take the skipping rope and enjoy skipping.
- Technique:

Swing rope forward and backwards, over the head, with stretched arms. Once the child is doing this fluently, do the following:- Swing rope forward, over the head, and then step over the rope. Repeat until learner can do this at a comfortable pace, without glitches, for quite a while. Increase pace gradually.

5.5 TEARING OF PICTURES

- Teach your child how to tear pictures out of a magazine.
- Technique:

Choose the picture you would like to tear out.
Press down and tear the page with the dominant hand from the top to bottom.

- Copy of Immunisation record.
- **Certified** copies of **both** parents' ID documents.
- Proof of residential address, not older than 3 months (W&L account in parent's name or lease agreement on official agency letterhead in parent's name).
- If you are not the biological parents, documents as proof of legal guardianship.
