5. Educational

5.1 SHOELACES

- Teach your child to tie his/her own shoelaces.
- Now is the ideal opportunity since the learners' wear shoes.

5.2 PUZZLE

- Build puzzles with your child.
- Technique:
 - Build the corners and sides first, and thereafter the centre part.
 - Let us look at the picture of the puzzle! (Visual discrimination).

5.3 TEARING OF PICTURES

- Teach your child how to tear pictures out of a magazine.
- Technique:
 - Choose the picture you would like to tear out.
 - Press down and tear the page with the dominant hand from the top to bottom.

5.4 MUSCLE TONE

- Muscle tone is the contraction of muscles which helps us keep our body in position.
 - Play with your child!!!
 - Kick a ball / Catch a ball / Kick a ball to a goal.
 - Barrel walking (lift and hold your child's feet and let him/her move forward with his/her arms).
 - Jump with one leg (left and right).
 - Do wagon wheels exercise.
 - Do summersaults.
 - Pull a rope at an acceptable speed, and the child must try and step on it, first with one foot, and then with the other.
 - Play "follow the leader". Take a rope/string and make different patterns with it and walk on the pattern.
 - Use two old coffee tins: Turn it upside down, pull a rope through holes on the sides to use as handles. Stand on the tins with the ropes in hand, and walk.
 - Sit criss-cross opposite each other and throw a bean bag or soft toy to each other.
 - Balance a pair of rolled sock on your head and try and walk with it.
- Notice your child's posture when he/she sits (sit straight-up).
- Notice your child's posture when he/she stands (must not "lean" against an object).

- Hasie Kwassie is proud of our extramural coaches, for always rendering services with a positive attitude.



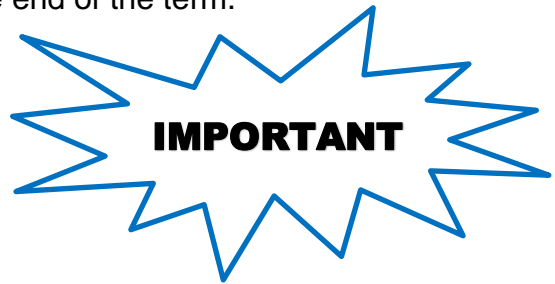

6.5 T-SHIRTS

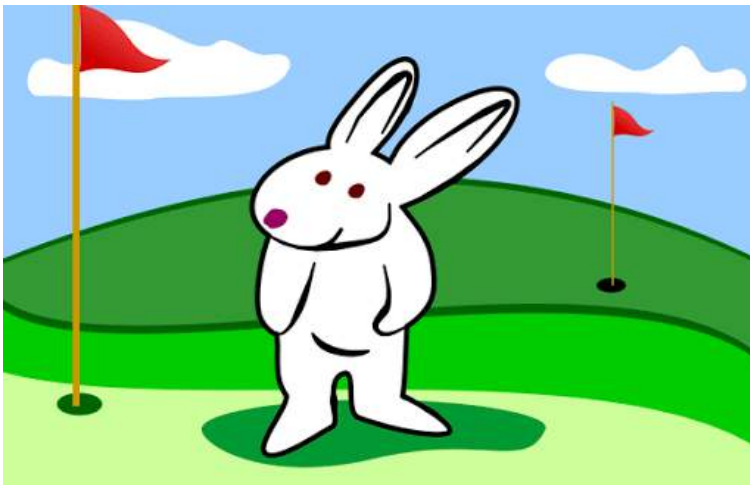
- Remember, specific Hasie Kwassie T-shirt for each day.

Our school's prospective Grade 1 - 2022 parents received a communique this week which must be returned, together with the following **compulsory supporting documents**, to your child's class teacher before or on 29 June 2021.

- **Certified** copy of child's **Unabridged Birth Certificate**.
- Copy of **Immunisation** record.
- **Certified** copies of **both** parents' **ID documents**.
- **Proof of residential address**, not older than 3 months (W&L account in parent's name or lease agreement on official agency letterhead in parent's name).
- If you are not the biological parents, documents as proof of legal guardianship.

We expect that the opening date for **Grade 1 - 2022** applications will soon be announced by the Department of Education. On the morning of the opening date, parents must apply **ONLINE** in accordance with departmental guidelines on: www.gdeadmissions.gov.za
