PRESIDENT'S ANNOUNCEMENT

The President addressed the nation again on Sunday evening and, amongst other things, announced that schools can start closing from 30 June 2021, and it is expected of all schools to close by the end of the week, 2 July 2021.

Further meetings will take place this week, whereafter the Minister of Basic Education will supply more information. There are, amongst others, still uncertainty regarding the date on which the third term will start, but for now it would appear that the date is 19 July 2021. We will keep you updated, as and when schools are supplied with more information.

We realize that there are currently more questions than answers, but let us use this week to close off safely and on a good note.

- 29 June 2021 Grade 4, 5, 6 & 7 Geography

Parents can thereafter come and fetch learners as follows:

10:00 Grade R, 1, 2 and 7
10:30 Grade 3, 4, 5 and 6

There will be supervision until 14:00 for learners who cannot be fetched earlier.

No extramural activities will take place.

- 30 June 2021 Grade 7 EMS
 Grade 4 – Grade 6 SOC

Parents can thereafter come and fetch learners as follows:

10:00 Grade R, 1, 2 and 7
10:30 Grade 3, 4, 5 and 6

There will be supervision until 14:00 for learners who cannot be fetched earlier.

No extramural activities will take place.

- 1 July 2021 Grade 7 Art (Please make use of the school hall gate)

All learners who could not complete assessments must report at the school hall, at 07:30 on 1 July 2021 and 2 July 2021, for the completion of outstanding assessments. These learners must please make use of the school hall gate.

Learners who tested positive and are isolating, will receive a -1 for the assessment which they were unable to write. This means that the assessment will not be taken into consideration during the calculation of marks. These learners will thus not be disadvantaged due to the fact that they did not write the assessments.
